

**Want to bring a
Karen Scholl, Horsemanship for Women™
hands-on clinic to *your* area?**



Hands-on clinics/courses are the **ideal** format for *accelerating your skills* with horses!

Videos, teleseminars, viewing the web site are all supportive formats, but nothing feels more *exhilarating* as when something you and your horse have been struggling with is quickly, effectively and safely resolved right in front of your eyes... and *you did it!*

Bring a clinic with Karen Scholl to your area so you and others can get the help you desire. It's as simple as set the date, gather the affordable clinic fees, arrange for an arena, and tell your friends!

Formats can be customized to fit the specific needs of your group, so think what it would be like to hold a private clinic with your riding club, 4-H group, Pony Club or other interest groups to promote ongoing study of the group long after the clinic is over! Or think if you arranged for a 'qualified' group of advanced participants to study more advancing techniques!

And, if you'd prefer fewer people at your clinic to get more individual attention, Karen's held these formats for as few as SIX people up to TWO WEEKS in a very private, accelerated, advancing format that took people *far beyond* what they had even imagined! Anything's possible and is only limited to your personal level of desire!

SET THE DATE!

Contact us with your requested date for a three-day clinic (Fri-Sat-Sun). If the date is available, we will hold that date for you on "tentative" status. Your date will change to the full "scheduled" status when the non-refundable deposit of \$1000 is received in our office. This can be done fairly easily by receiving a \$100 deposit from only ten participants, and the clinic can grow from there!

If your clinic date remains in “tentative” status up to 30 days prior, or if another clinic host requests the same date, you will be contacted to confirm the current status of filling your clinic and discuss whether it will become “scheduled” or not. The \$1000 non-refundable deposit can be applied to a future date at that time.

Try to select a date with mild weather since Karen will conduct the clinic rain or shine. An indoor or covered arena is not necessary but is recommended for the comfort of participants when scheduled during “off-season” months.

AFFORDABLE CLINIC FEES!

For domestic venues, the clinic fee is \$1500 per day plus expenses. Karen is available for international clinics, courses and tours. Fees are adjusted according to the request.

So, for a clinic fee of \$4500 for a three-day clinic, the \$1000 deposit is already received. Participants, even if it remains at the first ten people to sign up, have a balance due of only \$350 - now *that's affordable!*

Riders are limited to a maximum of fifteen with no minimum number. Clinics are minimum three days in length, usually Friday through Sunday, but can be adjusted if Sunday is a preferred family day for the group. Longer courses can also be arranged with an adjustment to the non-refundable deposit depending on the length of the course.

Final payment of the clinic fee is due thirty days prior to the clinic start date and travel expenses are to be reimbursed upon submission of receipts, to include round trip air fare, four-star hotel, full-size car rental and rental for approved speaker system. Incidentals such as meals are not included as expenses.

As the Clinic Host, you are encouraged to accept and hold checks for “full” payment from your riders to encourage their commitment to your clinic. You should price rider fees to cover the Clinic Fees and expenses plus an amount for unexpected expenses and your administrative time to arrange for the clinic.

Participant fees are only suggestions. You are free to set participant fees as you wish and any payments remaining after all expenses are paid are yours to keep as clinic host, to share with your riders, or use as a fund-raiser for your club or group!

RESERVE AN ARENA!

The arena should be fully fenced with gates and dimensions approximately 150' x 200' for fifteen riders or smaller for fewer riders. An obstacle course or round pen will always enhance the learning experience, but is not required.

The choice of using a covered/indoor arena depends on your expected weather as the clinic will continue as long as conditions safely permit. Arena expenses should include daily watering and dragging to minimize dusty conditions, and should have proper air flow/ventilation without losing the safety of being fully fenced.

TELL YOUR FRIENDS!

Clinics begin at 9:00 a.m. and wrap up around 4:00 p.m., though Karen is always flexible and happy to continue whenever a horse or person needs a little more help! Lunch time is used for discussion, questions and answers so you'll be sure to have all the time you need to 'get it'!

At no charge to you, we are happy to provide posters for you to put up at local feed & tack shops, artwork for any size ad you'd like to place in local horse publications, post cards to announce your clinic and will even put out a mailing in your area for only the expense of postage. All the promotional material you'd like, all at no cost to you!

All participants are in for a very exciting three days with Karen Scholl. Her fun, effective style of teaching will have you engaged within a very short time with your horse. Whether one brings a horse or observes, everyone participates equally as the learning environment 'unfolds' throughout the weekend.

Bringing lunch, snacks, water, hat, sunscreen, rain gear, chair and note pad all make the learning days more comfortable. Safe footwear with proper heel length and no heavy tread on the sole, leather latigos and cinches in good condition are a must. Certified protective riding helmets are by choice for adults and required for all minors at the request of Karen's insurance company.

Wondering which horse to bring? Karen's teaching is geared toward advancing the person's skill of communication with feel. Horses with extreme resistance are more difficult for the human to advance their skill with, so Karen suggests you study with your easiest horse first. If you have no alternative, by all means bring the horse you have and everything will be just fine. Sometimes people bring the most extreme horse at the barn and wonder why they didn't advance as far as others - it's simply because extreme horses have a longer way to go!

Karen suggests getting a head start learning her unique approach by studying her 'six-pack' of videos in advance of the clinic. There is such an extent of information that will be shared over the three days that the more advance study you can gain, the deeper the layer of learning you will experience. Rather than hearing *tons* of information and absorbing key elements, you'll have a strong basis of understanding and be able to more fully absorb the advancing knowledge every clinic has in store for you!

Everyone is nervous before coming to the clinic - though we're convinced we're the only ones! The environment is supportive, non-aggressive, and every moment is about

building on the skills to gain more confidence with horses. Though everyone is encouraged, no one is ever forced or intimidated into performing tasks they may find uncomfortable or fearful about. In such a case, Karen provides alternative tasks designed to build confidence at whatever stage that person is currently which will prepare them for future progression at their own comfortable pace!

Every breed and interest with horses will benefit from Karen's knowledge. Horses, mules, donkeys, from minis to drafts are all welcome to participate. All male equine must be gelded at least 90 days prior to the clinic. Stallions are excluded due to the fact that the more novice people can be unaware they may be creating a problem for even a well-mannered stallion.
